What information should you include?

A birth plan is a written outline of what you would like to happen during your labor and delivery. There are many different birth plan examples. Don't worry about making the "right one" for your labor and delivery. Jot down a few of your ideas and bring them up with your provider at your next prenatal visit.

After talking with your provider about your preferences, you can then finalize your birth plan. Keep in mind that having a birth plan does not guarantee that your labor and delivery experience will go accordingly. Unexpected things can happen as your labor progresses and plans can change. Remember that you and your healthcare team have a common goal: the safest possible delivery for you and your baby. A birth plan is a great starting point, but you should be prepared for changes as the situation dictates.
