



Current Visitor Restrictions

IMPORTANT: All exceptions to the visitation guidelines will be screened for respiratory symptoms, will have their temperature checked and will be provided a mask. If symptoms or an elevated temperature are present, entrance will not be permitted.

Hospital Floor

A patient who is staying overnight may have one visitor. This should be the same visitor over the course of a stay; no interchanging of visitors.

Exceptions include:

1. Minors may have either a parent or guardian.
2. Patients who are at the end of life may have additional visitors, if approved by the house supervisor.
3. Patients with altered mental status, developmental delays or behavioral health concerns may have one visitor.

These exceptions may spend the night, if approved by the house supervisor.

Emergency Department

Visitors are not allowed at this time.

Exceptions include:

1. Essential support person or caregiver.
2. Minors may have either a parent or guardian.
3. Patients with altered mental status, developmental delays or behavioral health concerns may have one visitor.

Surgical Services

Visitors are not allowed at this time.

Exceptions include:

1. Minors may have either a parent or guardian.
2. Patients with altered mental status, developmental delays or behavioral health concerns may have one visitor.

Family Birth Center

Family Birth Center patients may have one visitor. This should be the same visitor—from the same household—over the course of a stay; no interchanging of visitors. The visitor is permitted to leave and return throughout the course of the patient's stay.

Clinic and Other Outpatient Areas

Visitors are not allowed at this time.

Exceptions include:

1. Essential support person or caregiver.
2. Minors may have either a parent or guardian.
3. Patients with altered mental status, developmental delays or behavioral health concerns may have one visitor.
